Brief Report: The Department of Political Science at DWC organized a seminar on the "Socio-Economic Impact of Women Reservation in Local Self-Government" on 5 th May 2024. The seminar aimed to discuss the implications, challenges, and benefits of reserving seats for women in local self-governments (Panchayats and Municipalities) and to evaluate its impact on socio-economic development.

2. Inaugural Session

The seminar commenced with an inaugural session presided over by Dr. Mahananda Kanjilal, Principal of Durgapur Woman's College. In her welcome address, she emphasized the importance of women's participation in local governance and the transformative potential it holds for communities. The keynote address was delivered by Dr. Maidul Islam , a renowned political scientist, who highlighted the historical context and the legal framework of women's reservation in India.

Dr Islam discussed the 73rd and 74th Constitutional Amendments, which mandated a 33% reservation for women in Panchayats and Municipalities, respectively. He pointed out that this landmark legislation aimed to empower women politically, reduce gender disparities, and enhance socio-economic conditions in rural and urban areas.
