On 31.08.2023, the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC), Durgapur Women's College, organised a one-day workshop on the National Curriculum and Credit Framework of Kazi Nazrul University for 1st Semester Students of the College.

Dr. Dulal Chandra Sen, Coordinator, IQAC, introduced the topic deliberating on the key points of the NCCF as adopted by KNU. He emphasised the importance of the workshop for the newly admitted students who are to pursue their education under the new curriculum under **NEP 2020** at the College.


Dr. Amitay Chakraborty, Member, IQAC, conducted a session with a power-point presentation underscoring the salient features of the curriculum. He stressed upon the objective of the NCCF vis-a-vis **NEP 2020** as per UGC guidelines. He also familiarised the students with the credit division and the types, aims and objectives of various courses emphasising the importance of multidisciplinary and outcome-based objectives of the entire system.


Dr. Arup Kanti Kole, Member, IQAC, conducted a session with a power-point presentation explaining the modes of examinations, and method of marks calculation with reference to the University-approved formulae for SGPA and CGPA. He also explicated the pools of courses that are being offered to the students by the College as per University guidelines, and informed them about the credit banking and transfer system.

Around 200 students and 15 teachers of the College attended the workshop. The sessions were highly interactive as the attendees enthusiastically interacted with the speakers with their queries and doubts regarding the new system. However, there were few areas such as the selection of Major/Minor/MDC courses that were partially addressed. The attendees were assured by the speakers that those issues would be placed to the higher authorities for further clarification and resolved as soon as possible.
